Chinese Bridge is close to Town Hall providing access onto Portholme Meadow

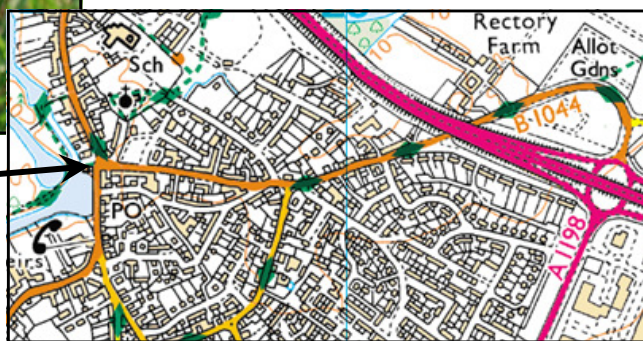
There is no fixed finishing time - participants can leave when they wish
